

Food in School/Nursery Snack

Please pay your child's snack money using the online system — iPayimpact if possible. Details on how to access this are detailed in a separate letter. Alternatively, you can make payments at the school office. Snack for the term can be made in 2 instalments please see the separate letter for this also. Parents are reminded that if your child brings a packed lunch to Nursery as they are here all day please ensure that this does not contain nut products as we have children with severe nut allergies. This includes products with chocolate spread.

Pupil Healthcare plans/Medication

All pupils with existing healthcare plans should come in to nursery to complete documentation for this session. If you would like this documentation to be sent home please contact Mrs Roy. Please note that we cannot administer any medication to your child without the completed forms and medication. Any new or existing parent who wishes to discuss the healthcare needs of their child in person should contact Mrs Roy or myself immediately if they have not done so already.

PEEP sessions

Mrs Beattie will be running 3 PEEP sessions for nursery children and their families this term starting on Friday 27th Sept and Friday 4th and 11th October. These fun and interactive sessions which will run between 11-12pm on these Friday mornings provide an opportunity to meet other parents as well as connect with your child through fun play based activities.
