

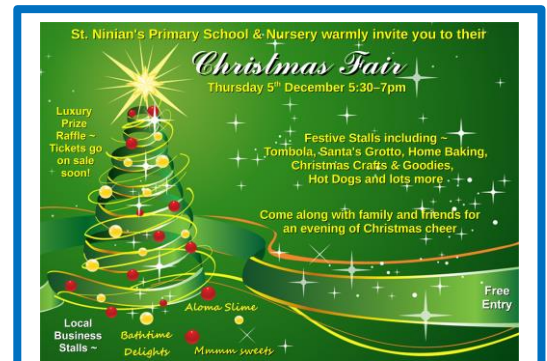

### Dress Down Day

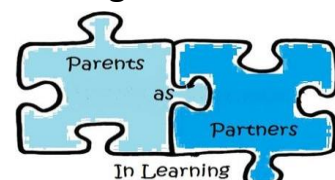
We plan to have a dress down day on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November** where we are asking pupils to bring in a donation for our school fair. No football strips or PJs.
