Our parent council and a grandparent have raised concerns about the movement of cars from the carpark during drop off and especially pick up of pupils from the Nursery gate. In response to this I invited a representative from West Lothian Council's Health and Safety team to view our arrangements and I have a meeting with a representative from WLC highways next week to look at reinstating the hatched school lines and the possibility of introducing yellow lines opposite the school and in the road ways leading up to the school. In the meantime if you are using the carpark outside the shops please ensure that you are in a designated bay. We would also ask parents to <u>not</u> park on the road opposite the gate of the Nursery or up at the shops until we can get a longer term solution. Please do not move your vehicle until all children are safely in cars. We would encourage as many parents as possible to park and stride. Thanks for your support with this. Mrs Smith
