Word Boost

Word boost is relaunching! Every week we read an exciting new book and learn 4 new boost words. These have been carefully selected by speech and language therapy (SALT). These 4 words and their meaning are embedded in our vocabulary over the course of the week. This is aimed at Pre-school children however any child who is interested can take part. By the end of their time in nursery the children will have learned 60 new words that they would not normally use. Some of the words include "Astonished" "Perch" "Delicious" and "Enormous"
