

Over the next 4 weeks we will be discussing this indicator with the children in nursery and in school. We will talk about how we can help to keep ourselves safe when in nursery, at home and out in the local community. We will share our learning on Twitter and on our weekly SWAY. Please talk with your child at home about being safe and ask them about what they have been learning about in nursery.

Welly Wednesday

We are aiming to restart our Wonderful Welly Wednesday walks once we have all the completed EE2 forms on 8th September and then every Wednesday following that. We will be out in the local community in all weathers so we advise that your child is appropriately dressed on these days, eg. Wellies, waterproofs, hats, gloves — please ensure these are all labelled with your child's name. Thank you.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: ANAPHYLAXIS ALLERGY

We have a child who has severe allergies. Therefore it is vitally important that your child DOES NOT bring in any of the following food types (in their bags, or without staff knowledge) which include the following ingredients: nuts, chocolate spread, peanut butter spreads, celery, sesame, banana, carrot, peas, lentils, wheat, yellow split peas and dairy. Please consult a member of staff if you have any concerns and we will be happy to discuss further. It is important to us that all of our children are safe and healthy in the Nursery and we appreciate your continued support.
