As part of our focus on ACTIVE some of the things we will be discussing and encouraging are: I can exercise, play, dance, take part in games and go on outdoor adventures. To help us with this we will be introducing 'Big Movement Time' for all our little learners. This will be a dedicated time in the school gym hall or outdoor spaces to participate in some big movement activities. Our AM session will be on a Friday and our PM session will be on a Monday. We would encourage children to be wearing comfortable clothing/footwear to help them move freely during these sessions.



Ordering lunches

As you enter the nursery we would encourage you to support your child in self-selecting their lunch choice for the day using our interactive display as this encourages your child's independence skills and express their personal preferences/choices. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions and offer support.

Meals Provision-PM sessions

From January 2023, our PM children are now entitled to a free hot meal in replace of their soup and sandwich which they have been receiving since August 2022. This has been a huge success so far with our afternoon children, lunches are being served daily in nursery from 12.30pm-1.00pm. The children have been developing their independence, table manners and developing social skills during their lunch time experience. If for any reason you do not wish your child to have a meal, please let a member of staff at the nursery know and provide a packed lunch for your child.

Update on our Nursery Improvement Plan Priorities

Our focus for October -December was to

- create a quiet, calm indoor sensory space for learners linked to the Zones of Regulation to support emotional wellbeing. This is now established in the space which used to be our nursery staff room/office area. The space has now been transformed with some sensory toys, books, soft lighting, a teepee, soft furnishings and some interactive walls.
- introduce a rhyme of the month to help learners listen and identify rhyming words. Each month in our newsletter we share the chosen rhyme with families, display this in the nursery environment, use QR codes for learners to hear the rhyme and say the rhyme together during our nursery day.
- gather parents/carers views on how we share wider achievements. We are in the process of creating a display in our cloakroom area where we will be sharing some photos of our learner's wider achievements. Our next steps:

- Continue daily wellbeing check ins looking at new ways to approach this, eg. Digital check in on promethean board, use of wellbeing characters, Together Time.
- Provide daily experiences, resources and interactions to promote number sense in the indoor and outdoor spaces with a particular focus on subitising
- Create opportunities for woodwork for all learners making connections to the world of work and local community.
