Wellbeing Indicator of the month - Included



Wider World of Work

The children in our AM and PM sessions have shown an interest in the wider world of work. Staff have been planning lots of experiences which allow the learners to find out about different jobs and places of work. So far we have had a visit from the librarian and visited

local shops and a Care Home.

We are currently working on our Family Calendar for this term and will be sharing this shortly with all families.

Gentle reminders

- During the nursery sessions children are able to have drinks of water or milk whenever they require. We kindly request that children do not bring in any other drinks/snacks with them, eg. Juice bottles/cartons - The exception to this is if your child brings a packed lunch as they can bring a small drink to have with their lunch or if there is a medical requirement.
- As the weather heats up you may want to consider providing the nursery with some sun cream for your child – this should be labelled clearly with your child's name.
- If your child requires any medication while at nursery please inform a member of staff and they will issue the paperwork for completion. All medication kept in nursery is reviewed every 3 months with parents/carers.

PEEP

Miss McNeil will be leading PEEP sessions again this term for us.

These sessions will be run on Fridays, 9-10am starting from:

Block 1: Friday 14th April until Friday 12th May Block 2: Friday 19th May until Friday 16th June.

Miss McNeil has confirmed the places for this session with families.

If you are unable to attend any of the sessions please let a member of the nursery team know in advance if possible.

The focus for these blocks will be 'Transition to P1'.
