


Saint Ninian's Nursery Class Newsletter-June

Nursery Events-June 2023

We can now confirm the arrangements for the events taking place in June:

Wednesday 7th June - Moving Up Morning for preschoolers- 9.15-10.30am

The children will have the opportunity to meet and work with their teacher and some of their new classmates in their P1 classroom. Each child will be invited to bring two adults with them to the Moving Up Morning morning. Whilst the children are enjoying time in their classroom, adults will be invited to stay and enjoy an informal chance to get to know other parents/families whilst enjoying a tea or coffee and a cake in our school hall.

During drop off/pick up times this week Miss Fraser will be asking parents/carers to complete a GLOW form to confirm whether you will be attending this event.

Wednesday 14th June – Picnic in the Park – Lanthorn Play park (10am – AM session 2pm-PM session)

Families are welcome to attend this event if they would like or are able to. There are some benches at the park but you are welcome to bring along a picnic blanket or collapsible chair to use. There are parking facilities near to the Lanthorn play park but there are no toilet facilities.

We will be leaving nursery at 10am and returning to nursery at 12pm for the AM session and then 2pm-4pm for the afternoon session

The children will be provided with a packed lunch on this day to have at the park.

Tuesday 20th June – Sports Day (10am – AM session 2pm-PM session)

Families are welcome to attend this event if they would like or are able to. If you are coming along we ask that you park in the car park beside the shops and not in the main school car park.

We aim to start the AM events at 10am and the PM events at 2pm. After the events your child can stay and finish their nursery session. We expect the activities to last an hour at the most.

This will take place outdoors on the grass area (bottom field in upper area of school) Children will take part in some races and we may even ask the adults to join it too!!

Tuesday 27th June-Leavers Event for preschool children (10.30am)

This event is for all preschool children (AM/PM & FD) Families are welcome to attend this event if they would like or are able to. This will be held in the outdoor classroom area (in front of main school reception-weather permitting). If you are coming along we ask that you park in the car park beside the shops and not in the main school car park. The children will have the chance to sing a little song, be presented with their certificates/gift and have some photographs taken. You are welcome to stay and join us for some light refreshments and snacks to celebrate this special day!
